TECH TIPS

Avoid Unnecessary Messages

Although System Galaxy does not require a door contact closure to operate, Technical Support recommends using a jumper wire to establish a closure is a door contact is not being used. This will prevent unnecessary Door Forced and Open Too Long messages if the controller is reset or loaded. Galaxy CPU boards come with an AC Failure and Low Battery warning circuit, but in most cases, these are not used. Use a jumper wire to close these circuits to avoid unnecessary AC Failure and Low Battery alarm messages when a controller is reset.

Hardware Enhancement: Battery Discharge Monitor

The maintenance free lead acid batteries that are supplied to provided power in case of AC power loss were developed in the 1970s. While this technology is mature, reliable, and inexpensive to manufacture, it does allow only a limited number of discharge cycles and cannot be stored in a discharged state. To prevent discharges from damaging the battery, Galaxy Control Systems recently began shipping a Battery Discharge Monitor with its controller enclosures. This device (BDM) is placed in series with the battery cable to prevent permanent damage to the backup battery. If the battery voltage drops below 8.5vdc (on a 12-volt battery), the BDM disconnects the battery and does not reconnect it until AC power is restored and the battery can begin recharging. The BDM comes installed by Galaxy manufacturing. The life expectancy of a lead acid battery is three to five years.
